From the Grand Chef

August 1st is Purple Heart Day. The Purple Heart medal is the oldest U.S. military decoration, established by General George Washington in 1782 to honor merit, especially among the enlisted soldiers. The original medal was a purple heartshaped piece of cloth edged with silver braid, and only three Revolutionary War soldiers received it from Washington himself. The award was forgotten for about 150 years until it was revived in 1931 by General Douglas MacArthur, who redesigned it with the help of an Army heraldic specialist. The Purple Heart is now awarded for bravery in action and for wounds received in combat. If you hold a Purple Heart and have not filed for VA Compensation and Pension you need to see a service officer and file.

National Aviation Day is observed in the United States on August 19 each year to celebrate the history and development of aviation. It coincides with the birthday of Orville Wright who, together with his brother Wilbur, made significant contributions to powered flight. The holiday was established in 1939 by Franklin Delano Roosevelt, who issued a presidential proclamation which designated the anniversary of Orville Wright's birthday to be National Aviation Day. Each year the president may issue a proclamation to designate August 19 as National Aviation Day; call on government officials to display the flag of the United States on all government buildings on the day; and invite people living in the United States to observe the day with appropriate exercises to further stimulate interest in aviation in

their communities.

The Grand has many things coming up the pike. In October we have the Training Seminar. In April 2024 the Grand is planning a cruise to the Bahamas. Now with that in mind, we need to get members. We have 517 members in the state. Some voitures have but three members. Some meet in restaurants. Some don't meet at all. Greetings Voyageur's keeping with tradition I want to bring everyone this annual reminder, on why we as Veterans never break the colors.

"Never Break the Colors"

Our unwritten tradition of never breaking the Colors has always been a finable offense but few of us know why. Thanks to some research by Monsieur Pat Beamer, Chef de Chemin de Fer 2013, the genesis of our tradition appears to come from our history with the American Legion. According to American Legion custom and flag etiquette, the area between flags posted for a meeting is considered "Hallowed Ground," representing the graves of our fallen comrades. No person is to reach between the flags to hand or receive items from the speaker or table, thus preserving the honor and respect to our fallen Veterans.

Here is a poem written by Past Florida Department American Legion Commander, Nolle Deas, 1973-74, about the Hallowed Ground:

THIS IS HALLOWED GROUND

WHY YOU DON'T WALK OR REACH BETWEEN THE COLORS

Between the flags that proudly fly Let no one dare to stand For here our fallen comrades lie. We call it Hallowed Ground. A symbol, yes, but mark it well; *Here let us ever humbly pause* In Memory of the ones who fell In fighting for our sacred cause. On sea or land these buddies died. Some lie beneath a foreign sod In graves caressed by winds and tide, In spots unknown to all but God. And so this place is Hallowed Ground. And it shall be forever blessed. 
