There are obligations governing the Cheminots and are listed in the Grande du Florida's Constitution and can be found in Article VII. Sections 2-7. These Cheminots are listed in Article VII, Section 1 (the last item on the list). With this being said - there have been changes in the Region's delegates. These changes will forthcoming with the 2024 Grand Officer's List and that will be sent to all of the officers, elected or appointed, the Regional Cheminots, Past Grand Chefs de Gare, current Voiture Locale Chefs de Gare and Voiture Locale Correspondants.


At the grand the nurses training committee will select one applicant for the scholarship. The amount has not been set yet.




