Grand Correspondant

Just got back from another whirlwind of travel. The past several weeks, I have attended The Cajun Wreck in New Iberia, Louisiana. I was in good company at The Great Western Promenade in Rapid City, South Dakota and Southland's Dixie Promenade in Alexandria, Louisiana. I have had the most wonderful time with old friends and meeting new friends. This past weekend, I participated as the Conducteur on the Ritual Team and was the prostituting attorney during the trials at the Gator Wreck in Goose Creek, South Carolina (my old stomping ground) where my husband participated as the Chairman of the So-Long-League, among other tasks. Although the number of PGs were only 6, it was more easily handled than the 22 we were expecting. This Friday, I will be heading to Arlington for the Memorial Day Ceremonies followed immediately by the Great Lakes Promenade in Okemos, Michigan.

The Grand Promenade is only a few weeks away. That means elections are upon you at the Voiture level. I have received only 5 Officer Rosters out of 27 Locales in the Grand. Those received are V-294, V-304, V-472, V-1621, and V-1490. The Grand Correspondant needs to have a copy of each Locale's Officer list **PRIOR** to the Grand Promenade. The dates for the Grand Promenade are June 8-11, 2023. The registration form is attached to this bulletin. Officers MUST attend the Grand Promenade. Plan accordingly.

Also, I have received some of the Program reports but none of the one for Youth Sports. Since there isn't a Grand Youth Sports Directeur it falls on the Grand Correspondant to receive the reports.

If you are confused as to which positions are elected, here is the list:

- Grand Chef de Gare
- Grand Chef de Train

- Grand Conducteur
- ➤ Grand Garde de la Porte (2)
- Grand Commis Voyageur
- > Grand Commissaire Intendant

This list constitutes "the chairs." Grand Commissaire Intendant is not actually part of the chairs as not everyone has the capability to manage the financial side.

Those wishing to be appointed to a Grand position must let the Voiture's Chef de Gare know so your name can be submitted to the <u>current</u> Grand Chef, who will pass the information to the <u>incoming</u> Grand Chef. Please be aware that an appointed position, also, has expectations of the office.

Any Voyageur wishing to run for an **ELECTED** position at the Nationale level MUST submit a Resolution to their Voiture, who must vote to approve your resolution. The Voiture Chef de Gare/Voiture Correspondant must forward the approved resolution to the Grand Correspondant thirty (30) days prior to the Grand Promenade so the Resolution Committee can review and recommend to the membership to approve the resolution to be sent to Nationale. An appointment on the Nationale level needs a letter of request for nomination to their Voiture, who must recommend you and forward the approved recommendation to the Grand Correspondant thirty (30) days prior to the Grand Promenade, same system as for an elected National position. **EVERY POSITION FOR NATIONALE MUST** BE VOTED ON BY THE GRAND MEMBERSHIP TO BEFORE BEING FORWARDED TO NATIONALE FOR CONSIDERATION.

- ◆ALL CANDIDATES MUST BE IN GOOD STANDING WITH THE LOCALE, WITH THE GRAND AND WITH NATIONALE.
- ◆IMPORTANT NOTE: LEARN WHAT YOUR POSITION IS, WHAT YOUR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES ARE <u>BEFORE</u> YOU

REQUEST THE NOMINATION OR GET ELECTED/APPOINTED.

Regional delegate's name and contact information: This is not anything new, each Region MUST elect a delegate every year. The following Regions do not have a current delegate: 1, 4A, 6B*, 7, 8, 12, 13, 15*, and 17*. (*These Regions only have 1 Locale.) These delegates are considered part of the Grande's Cheminots. There are obligations governing the Cheminots and are listed in the Grande du Florida's Constitution and can be found in Article VII, Sections 2-7. These Cheminots are listed in Article VII, Section 1 (the last item on the list).

◆ IF YOUR REGION HAS THE SAME DELEGATE AS THE PREVIOUS YEAR, THAT NAME AND CONTACT INFORMATION MUST BE SENT AS WELL. DO NOT ASSUME THAT THE GRAND CORRESPONDANT CAN READ YOUR MINDS.

WHO ARE YOUR VOTING DELEGATES????

DELEGATE STRENGTH ARTICLE IV, SECTION 2: "In the Grande Promenade every Voiture Locale shall be entitled to two (2) delegates and two (2) alternate delegates for the FIRST fifteen (15) members and one (1) additional delegate and one additional alternate delegate for each additional fifteen (15) members, or major fraction thereof, provided that the per capita tax has been paid and was properly reported of the regulation membership forms provided by Voiture Nationale, and which have been actually received Voiture Nationale at least fifteen (15) days prior to the date of the holding of the

Grande Promenade".

Your voting strength is based on how many members are current with their dues. Your Voiture may be entitled to 7 votes but if only 70 have paid their dues, your Voiture will only be entitled to 6 votes. So, in order to be able to utilize the maximum voting strength of your Locale's membership must be at 100%. I will be checking Grand du Florida's roster 10 days prior to the Grand Promenade. Anyone who has not paid their dues up to that date will not be eligible to attend Promenade giving up the benefit of their vote. This could very well change the outcome of an election.

THE ART OF PERSUASION – GENERAL GEORGE C. MARSHALL

The Time and Place Committee has negotiated with the above mentioned hotel and are confident that you will be pleased with the choice made on your behalf.

The 101st Grand Promenade is called to convene June 8-11, 2023, at the Courtyard Orlando Lake Buena Vista at Vista Centre in Orlando, Florida.

The 101st Grand Promenade is called for the purpose of electing Officers and Directeurs and for transactions of such business as may come before it.

In accordance with the Grand Constitution of the Grand Voiture du Florida, each Voiture Locale shall be entitled to two (2) delegates and two (2) alternates for the first 15 members, and in addition thereto, one (1) delegate and one (1) alternate for each additional 15 members or major fraction thereof. Additional votes for Grand Officers shall be provided for in the Grand Constitution of Grand du Florida.

All other business of the 101st Grand Promenade shall be in accordance with the Constitution of the Grand Voiture as amended June of 2021 at Orlando, Florida.

STANDING RULES OF PROCEDURE (101st) ANNUAL GRANDE PROMENADE

Grande Voiture du Florida June 8, 2023, in Orlando, Florida

The following Special Rules are hereby adopted to govern the Grande Promenade held at the Courtyard Orlando Lake Buena Vista at Vista Centre in Orlando, Florida June 8, 2023

- 1. Matters of procedure not provided for in the Constitution of the Grande Voiture du Florida or in these Special Rules shall be covered by Robert's Rules of Order.
- 2. When a delegate desires to offer a notion or address the Grande Promenade, they shall rise, address the chair as "MONSIEUR GRAND CHEF DE GARE," and upon receiving recognition, shall state his/her name and the Voiture Locale to which he/she belongs before proceeding.
- 3. Any resolution shall not be considered by the Grande Promenade unless presented to the Grand Correspondant in writing prior to the opening of the Grande Promenade. A two-thirds (2/3) vote of the delegates at the Grande Promenade is required for consideration of the resolution originating on the floor, which must be in writing. All resolutions shall be referred to the Resolutions Committee for further consideration and recommendation.
- 4. The voting order procedure used shall be that in which a tag bearing the number of each Voiture Locale in the Grande Voiture du Florida be placed in a container and drawn at random to determine the order of voting. The Chairman of each Voiture Locale delegation shall poll his delegation on the floor and shall announce the vote of his delegation. The vote of the Grand Chefs de Gare Passé and the Grand Voiture Officers shall be added to and included in the roll call vote of each delegation, as appropriate, and in accordance with Article IV, Sections 2 and 3 of the Constitution of the Grande Voiture du Florida. The voting order will be drawn and the Grand Wreck, or if not Grand Wreck takes place, prior to the convening of the Grande Promenade, and no publication of the voting order will be made.
- 5. Consent of two-thirds (2/3) of the delegates present is necessary for suspension of these Special Rules. Provisions of the Constitution of the Grande Voiture du Florida may NOT be suspended, altered, amended, or nullified except as provided in Article X of the Constitution of the Grande Voiture du Florida.
 - 6. A delegate shall be properly registered when it is shown that his name is registered as being present at the Grande Promenade in accordance with the certification to the Grand Correspondant by the Voiture Locale as elected and the proper registration fee for each delegate has been paid. All Grand Chefs de Gare Passé and Grand Voiture Officers must be registered and have paid the proper registration fee to be entitled to vote on any and all questions before the Grande Promenade.


